

Global Plan to End TB

- Global Plans are costed plans and roadmap for concerted response to TB
- Important tools for advocacy
- Developed through an inclusive process
- Current plan ends 2022

Proposal: New plan covering 2023-2030

- Focussed on ending TB
- Aligned with:
 - SDG target
 - WHO End TB Strategy
 - Global Fund Strategy




Global Plans for TB in the SDG era

Process of developing the Global Plan 2023-2030

- Guidance provided by Global Plan **Task Force**
 - Possible same Task Force that developed the current Global Plan, with revision to increase country level engagement and additional expertise as needed.
- **Meetings** (virtual/in-person)
 - Task Force: 3 meetings and consultation calls as needed
 - Consultations with Civil Society Organizations (by region: Asia, Africa and EECA)
 - Consultations with other partners: NTPs, technical partners, donors, private sector
 - New Tools Working Groups
- On-line **public consultations** – one during scoping and another with an advanced draft
- **Modelling, costing** and analytic work
- Writing, editing, design work and translations
- **Budget** implication: USD 350,000. Funding is available
