Evolution of UNOPS Hosting Model

- UNOPS hosting model evolved since Stop TB joined in 2015; additional 5 entities have joined UNOPS since then.
- New [Operational Instruction \(OI\)](#) for Hosting services and new standard template for the applicable hosting terms ([Joint Hosting Agreements](#)).
- The goal is to have a standardized approach, full clarity on roles and responsibilities, and to bring the hosted entities even closer into the UNOPS programme and operational environment.
- OI promulgated in January 2021; will now become relevant for Stop TB.

Relevance and Requirements for Stop TB

- Majority of OI requirements already in place for Stop TB, including eligibility criteria, governance, branding, management requirements.
- 3 aspects require further work over the coming months:
 - a. Adjust JHA template for Stop TB (to be annexed to donor agreements)
 - b. Integrate Stop TB into the UNOPS IT platform and G-suite
 - c. Integrate portfolio management team into the Secretariat
- No real material change for STBP, but strengthened service delivery; will be cost neutral; and will begin implementation of outstanding elements with Secretariat, Board/EC and key donors over the coming months.
