



Project Location: Dak Nong Province, Binh Phuoc Province, Thai Binh Province, Ninh Binh Province, Nghe An Province.

Timeline: March 2023 – March 2024

Aim:

- To activate provincial Committees to End TB to take their leadership role to mobilize and coordinate different stakeholders to strengthen provincial TB response, so that provincial and national TB targets will be met with community engagement, rights protection, and gender equity.

Objectives:

- To improve the commitment and engagement of Provincial Steering Committee to End TB/Provincial stakeholders in monitoring and ensuring the achievement of the goal of ending TB by 2030 is enhance by 2025 in 8 provinces (Dak Lak, Gia Lai, Dak Nong, Binh Phuoc, Hai Phong, Hai Duong, Thai Binh, Nghe An)
- To increase the participation of representatives of communities affected by TB from 8 provinces in TB program at all levels
- To participate and engage in TB advocacy and accountability initiatives at the national, regional and global levels.

Overall aim:

- To empower local communities with TB and CRG awareness and strengthen community systems for the development, delivery and monitoring of TB response which provides people-centered, non-stigmatizing and gender-sensitive TB treatment support in hard-to-reach settings.

Proposal Objectives

- To empower local communities to participate in the development and delivery of TB responses in ethnic minority and remote communities
- To build a community-led action plan to mitigate accessibility barriers to TB diagnosis and people-centered treatment and care in ethnic minority and remote communities.
- To integrate and evaluate stigma and gender barrier reduction components into the community-led action plan based on stigma and gender assessment results.
